Cellphone Policy

EXCELSIOR PRIMARY SCHOOL

POLICY REGARDING POSSESSION AND USE OF CELLULAR PHONES AND LISTENING DEVICES BY LEARNERS

- Cellular phones are to be switched off as from 07:45 and may only be switched on at 14:00
- No cellular phones may be used for any purpose during school hours [breaks included]
- Should a cellular phone be seen at any stage during school hours, it will be confiscated immediately and only returned after 5 school days
- Furthermore, the particular learner's parents will be notified of this, either telephonically or via a note in the homework diary.
- The above policy of confiscation also applies to any situation where a
 learner is found using his/her cellular phone for sending and/or
 receiving any type of inappropriate material during any time while
 he/she is involved in any type of school activity or is on the school
 premises.
- Should a learner be found making use of any type of listening device [ipod, mp3 player etc.] during school hours, a similar policy of confiscation will be enforced.
- The school accepts no responsibility should a cellular phone or similar device be stolen and/or damaged and no investigation will be launched into such matters i.e. these items are brought to school at own risk.
 - These measures have become necessary to protect learners from occurrences such as vulgar language, pornography and general disruption of classroom and other related activities.
